# PENDING BILLS REPORT

PENDING BILLS REPORT FOR PERIOD ENDING 31st March, 2025

## **Executive Summary**

As at 30th March 2025, the County Government of Kericho reported pending bills amounting to Kshs. 1.147 billion, comprising Kshs. 936.3 million (82%) in development expenditure and Kshs. 211.6 million (18%) in recurrent expenditure. Out of this, Kshs. 582.6 million (51%) had been settled, leaving Kshs. 565.3 million (49%) outstanding. Departmental performance varied significantly: Trade (96%), Agriculture (92%), Health (88%), and Water and Environment (86%) posted the highest settlement rates, while Finance (27%), Public Works and Roads (33%), ICT (26%), and Public Service Management (10%) recorded the lowest, highlighting priority areas for intervention.

To address these fiscal challenges, the Pending Bills Committee has been instrumental in verifying the validity of bills to ensure compliance with procurement and financial regulations, prioritizing settlement based on urgency and service delivery impact, and developing a sustainable settlement strategy aligned with budgetary constraints. The committee has also enhanced transparency by establishing clear verification, payment, and reporting processes, while collaborating with stakeholders—including suppliers, contractors, the World Bank, and KDSP II—to foster trust and facilitate resolution. In addition, the committee continues to monitor progress, provide regular updates, and recommend systemic improvements to prevent future accumulation of bills through stricter expenditure controls and efficient payment systems.

Overall, while progress has been made in settling over half of the pending bills, the outstanding balance remains a significant fiscal risk. Strengthening revenue mobilization, enforcing expenditure discipline, and fully implementing the committee's recommendations will be critical in restoring supplier confidence, safeguarding service delivery, and ensuring sustainable financial management

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The stock of pending bills for the County Government of Kericho has continued to accumulate despite efforts to prioritize their payment. This challenge has adversely affected budget implementation, liquidity of the private sector, and the financial stability of businesses, particularly micro and small enterprises that depend heavily on county contracts. Pending bills remain a recurring fiscal issue, undermining service delivery and raising concerns about long-term financial sustainability.

#### 2. Historical Trends

Over the last five financial years (FY 2019/20 to FY 2023/24), the county's approved budgets have ranged between Kshs. 6.9 billion and Kshs. 8.4 billion (excluding the County Assembly allocation). During this period, pending bills have steadily increased, both in absolute terms and as a proportion of the approved budget.

FY 2019/20: Pending bills stood at Kshs. 463.8 million (6% of the approved budget).

FY 2020/21: Pending bills rose slightly to Kshs. 465.1 million (7%).

FY 2021/22: Pending bills increased to Kshs. 515.1 million (7%).

FY 2022/23: Pending bills were Kshs. 526.2 million (6%).

FY 2023/24: Pending bills surged to Kshs. 1.147 billion (15%).

This sharp increase highlights growing fiscal pressures and inefficiencies in managing expenditure.

# 3. Status as at Q3 of FY 2024/25

As at 30th March 2025 (end of Quarter 3), the County Government reported total pending bills of Kshs. 1.15 billion, of which Kshs. 936.3 million (82%) related to development expenditure and Kshs. 211.6 million (18%) related to recurrent expenditure. By the same period, the county had settled Kshs. 582.6 million (51%) of the obligations, leaving an outstanding balance of Kshs. 565.3 million (49%).

Departments such as Trade (96%), Agriculture (92%), Health (88%), and Water and Environment (86%) recorded the highest settlement rates, while Finance (27%), Roads (33%), ICT (26%), and Public Service Management (10%) had the lowest settlement levels, reflecting uneven performance across departments.

### 4. Implications

The persistence of pending bills has had several implications:

- a) **Budget Execution:** Funds earmarked for new projects are constrained as a significant portion is diverted to arrears.
- b) **Private Sector Liquidity:** Delayed payments undermine the financial health of suppliers, particularly SMEs.
- c) **Service Delivery:** Unpaid obligations stall projects and disrupt essential services.
- d) **Fiscal Sustainability:** The sharp rise in pending bills raises concerns about expenditure control.

### 5. Ongoing Interventions

To address these challenges, the County Government has partnered with the World Bank through the Kenya Devolution Support Program (KDSP II) to develop a comprehensive strategy for managing pending bills. The initiative focuses on strengthening financial accountability, enforcing fiscal discipline, and ensuring timely settlement of obligations. Additionally, the program supports capacity building to improve expenditure planning, enhance revenue mobilization, and introduce robust monitoring frameworks for pending bill clearance.

#### 6. Committee objective.

The Pending Bills Committee's main objective is to verify the validity of all pending bills to ensure compliance with procurement laws, contracts, and financial regulations. It prioritizes the settlement of verified bills based on urgency, legal obligations, and service delivery impact, while promoting transparency through clear processes for verification, payment, and documentation. The committee also seeks to develop a sustainable settlement strategy aligned with budgetary constraints, strengthen financial management systems to prevent future bill accumulation, and recommend stricter expenditure controls. Collaboration with stakeholders, including suppliers, contractors, the World Bank, and KDSP II, is emphasized to foster trust and smooth resolution. Additionally, the committee is mandated to monitor progress, provide regular updates, build capacity of county staff, and address legal or policy gaps contributing to recurring pending bills, thereby ensuring sustainable fiscal practices.

As at 30th March 2025, the County Government had accumulated pending bills totaling Kshs. 1,147,933,403. Out of this, development expenditure accounted for Kshs. 936,319,678 while recurrent expenditure stood at Kshs. 211,613,725. By the reporting date, a total of Kshs. 582,604,175, representing 51 percent of the overall pending bills, had been settled, leaving an outstanding balance of Kshs. 565,329,228 or 49 percent.

departmental settlement status shows that Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries cleared 92 percent of its obligations, paying Kshs. 54.2 million out of Kshs. 58.7 million. Similarly, the Department of Trade, Industrialization, Innovation, Tourism and Wildlife demonstrated strong performance by settling 96 percent of its bills, while Health and the Water, Environment, Energy, Forestry and Natural Resources department cleared 88 percent and 86 percent of their respective obligations. These departments reflect commendable progress in addressing their financial commitments.

On the other hand, Education, Culture, Libraries and Social Services achieved an 83 percent settlement rate, while Lands, Housing and Physical Planning cleared 53 percent of its bills. The Executive Office of the Governor and the County Public Service Board recorded moderate settlement levels of 42 percent and 43 percent respectively.

Departments with notably low settlement rates include Finance and Economic Planning, which cleared only 27 percent of its pending bills, Public Works, Roads and Transport at 33 percent, and Information, Communication, Technology and E-Government at 26 percent. Public Service Management recorded the lowest performance with only 10 percent of its bills paid. These low levels of settlement present significant risks to contractors and suppliers and could impact service delivery if not addressed.

Overall, development-related bills form the largest share of the pending obligations, with 52 percent settled, while recurrent bills had a lower settlement rate of 46 percent. The analysis reveals a disparity in departmental performance, with some sectors nearly clearing their obligations while others continue to lag behind significantly. **See annex I & II For Details** 

To address the outstanding bills, priority should be given to departments with the lowest settlement levels such as Finance and Economic Planning, Public Works, ICT, and Public Service Management. Strengthening revenue collection, enforcing budgetary controls, and ring-fencing funds for bill clearance would help reduce accumulation of arrears. In addition, developing clear payment schedules and engaging suppliers transparently will restore confidence and safeguard service delivery. Establishing a quarterly review mechanism will also enhance accountability and ensure steady progress in clearing pending bills.

In conclusion, while the county has made commendable progress by settling over half of the pending bills, urgent measures are required to address the outstanding Kshs. 565.3 million, particularly in departments with low settlement rates, in order to enhance fiscal discipline and sustain service delivery.

#### 7. Recommendations

- a) Prioritize Settlement in Low-Performing Departments.
- b) Enforce Expenditure Controls to prevent further accumulation.
- c) Enhance Revenue Mobilization.
- d) Implement Supplier Payment Plans to rebuild confidence.
- e) Institutionalize Quarterly Reviews for accountability.

#### 8.Conclusion

The Quarter 3 review highlights that while 51 percent of the county's pending bills have been cleared, the outstanding stock of Kshs. 565.3 million remains a significant fiscal concern. The surge in pending bills in FY 2023/24 underscores the urgency of adopting stricter financial discipline, stronger monitoring, and targeted interventions. With the support of KDSP II and other partners, the County Government has an opportunity to reform its financial management framework and ensure that pending bills are progressively reduced, fostering fiscal sustainability and uninterrupted service delivery.
